went to Town, nothing particular
occured, returned Home to Dinner.
got in a Stack of Oats —

Peach Trees are all in full bloom
and Apple Trees just opening
in the Bud, Oats & Clover are come
up very fine & Vegetation generally
very forward —

10th A cool morning & high Wind at
N.W., but no Frost, went to Town
Returned Home to Dinner —
began to ^{plough} new lot, which
turns up much better than I
expected —
