9th Sunday, A fine morning but cold,
Mr. T. very unwell — Mr. Peters
call'd, rode with him to Fuley and
dined there, Mr. Bowly thinks the
Frost has killed the Peach buds —
10th A cold day, Mr. T. much better,
Sow'd Cato in new Lot, which is
in excellent order, John Conrad
employ'd pruning Orchard, John
Shangle planting Locust Trees
next the Fence on East side of
Meadow, Harry left me this day

On Tuesday last went with the
Cout to get some Aspin Trees to
Plant round the Milk House, call'd
at Fuley for a Horse Chesnut
which planted in Front of House
opposite the West wing, Mr. Hilton
brought me 100 Locusts, planted
some with the Aspines round
the Milk House —

15th (Saturday), All this week been very
Cold with Frosty Nights, which
has a very injurious effect on vegeta-
tion generally, as the whole month
of February was very mild & made
the Fruit very forward, it is now
thought to be injur'd thereby, we
had a heavy Shower of Snow this day.
Dined with Mr. Gates on Mutton
