Planted 20 Rows of Potatoes, which is second Planting this Spring, this evening more mild, the wind having changed, is now Southerly, Brown Hen hatched 12 Chickens, first this Spring —

19. A wet Stormy day, with some Snow wind N.E. Dined at Mr. Harris's off Mr. Bowly's Saddle of Mutton, 15 in company —

20. Rained all Day, did not go to Town, wind N.E. & cold —

21. A fine day, wind S.W. & mild

22. Saturday — A fine day, got in a Stack of Hay, rolled new Timothy meadow which was Manu's last month — Paid Smewings wages in full to this day —

23 Sunday — Dined at Furley with ~~my~~ all my Family & Mr. Wrigman no other company, a cold day —

24. A very cold morning with Snow, which continued all the forenoon ~~morning~~, wind N.E. which changed at 12 O'clock to N.W.
