- 13 - Return'd Home with Mr. Galt, Mrs. T. & Children spent the day at Furley, Hot weather & remarkably dry -

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- 14 - Monday, engaged to dine with Mr. S^r. Thomas at Fletchers Spring in company with Mrs. T. & the Ladies from Furley &c. &c., had a very pleasant day but met with some unfavorable occurrences in the evening which are better forgot than recorded.
