dinner — S. Bowley din'd with us.

Continuation of fine weather —
7. Went to Town & din'd at Mr. Wing-
mans — The Clifton arriv'd after a
short passage of 14 days to the Capes,
full cargo. 200 Hds Sugar for myself,
& full of Passengers —

Weather good, Sow'd this day twelve
bushels of Oats in the Field purchased
of Gorsuch, ground in fine Order —
Very early for Sowing Grain —

8th Sunday — Disagreeable weather,
Wind N. E. & light Rain all day —

Mr. Nicols call'd after dinner in his
Carriage & took me & Gen. Miller to visit
Col. Hall, found him well & alone —
