15 May - Steady Rain last Night and continued all this day, at times very heavy, Wind N. E. & high, quite cool. A good Fire is required, consequently very unfavorable for vegetation, and particularly for Corn, much of it will be washed away, & probably the remainder rotting in the ground.

Went to Town, dined with So. Sterett en-famille.

16 - A very disagreeable day with some Rain, wind still N. E. and cold.

Went to Town, dined with S. Sterett. Purchased a Cow & calf for \$26 1/2.

Our three Boys came down from Pomona to spend Whitsuntide at home. They are all very well.

Paid Vache in full to this day.
