A heavy Shower at 6 O'clock with an appearance of continued Rain.

The Gentlemen all staid Tea, & Mr. Moore all Night.

20 - Very disagreeable forenoon, Cloudy & cool - at 3 O'clock began to Rain & continued uncommonly heavy untill Six, with appearance of still more, Wind E & N. E.

Went to Town, attended the District Court as a Jurymen, nothing done, returned Home to Dinner.

Our three Sons returned to School in the forenoon - Heavy Thunder this afternoon 2 hours.
