Finished Mowing my Timothy this day, which proves an excellent Crop & so far well secured, altho' we have had a good deal of Rain, yet at intervals the weather was very favorable -

22 - Fine morning but a severe Thunder gust & heavy Rain at 3 O'clock, which disappointed me very much, being busy making a Hay Rick -

Went to Town & returned to Dinner, Chartered the Fame for Cadiz at \$12.50. bailed to a Spaniard who puts her under Spanish colors -

23 - Very fine pleasant day -

Went to Town & returned to dinner -

Mr. Gadsby with his Daughter Mrs. Chapman & children call'd in the afternoon, and

Mrs. J. Hollingsworth with two daughters paid a visit in the Forenoon -

Put up much fine Hay to day -

24 - Very fine cool day, went to Town & returned to Dinner -

After a heavy Harvest, we this day finished getting up all my Hay, besides filling the Stable Lofts, I have 9 Stacks and One Rick, which on a moderate calculation amounts to upwards of 60 Tons of as fine Hay as was ever made, & also 9 Acres of Rye & 6 of Oats, all which has been effected without any quarrelling or disturbance amongst the Laborers -

Becky Peters came to Dinner, and afterwards walk'd with Mrs. J. to Mrs. S. Steretts & drank Tea, Mrs. & Miss Sally Peters came & drank Tea at Clifton, Becky staid all Night -
