3 - Fine cool day, went to Town & returned to Dinner, at which we had D. A. Smith & Peter Weigman.

4 - Very pleasant day altho' Cloudy, went to Town & took Soup at the French Tavern, having been taken very unwell last Night, but am better to day.

Commenced Mowing second Crop of Clover, which is very fine.

Masons began Stone Wall in my Stable Yard.

Beckey Peters went Home & Mr Moore walk'd out & staid all Night.

5 - Fine day, went to Town & returned to Dinner, some appearance of a Mob last Night about the Post Office, in consequence of the Fed^l Republican being bro^g by Mail from Geo. Town, but the Military being call'd out dispers'd the multitude, threats have however been us'd of violence being offer'd this Night, and the Troops have orders to turn out.

Col^l Hall call'd on his way Home in the evening.

6 - Showery day but clear evening, went to Town & din'd with Mrs Campbell & Jo. Herrett also there. The Military last Night kept all quiet.

7 - Went to Town - Din'd at Mrs Kings.

Patrolled the Town with my Troop this Night untill 12 O'clock & then return'd Home, all quiet, Mr Betts provided a Supper for us.
