Sept. 1 - Fine day but warm, went to Town & returned to dine with Mr. Nicols, a small party but very agreeable, came home early -

2 - Went to Town & returned to dinner, delivered Mr. Walter Saunders his brother Charles Cloaths &c. -

Mr. Baxter came out after dinner & staid all Night, a pleasant Shower of Rain at 5 O'clock P.M. -

3 - Fine day, went to Town & returned to Dinner - Brown Horse Shoe -

Mrs. Nicols & Mrs. Troup came and Drank Tea, I walked over with them to Darby, also Bowley & Hal -

Mr. Moore came out & staid all night, 4 - Thunder & heavy Rain last Night, which continued at intervals all forenoon, went to Town accompanied by Mr. Moore in the Gig, dined at So. Sterett's with Doct. Mathews, So. Sterett, C. S. Ridgely & Vance
