6 Oct^r. A very fine cool day Wind N.W. went to Town, accompanied Mrs. Baton & her Family on Board the Henry, with which they were much pleas'd, but afterwards hearing that the Algerines had declar'd War against America, they decline going to Lisbon, this Ship is now call'd the Eagle - Dined with Mr. Robt. Patterson, as did Mr. Brighton.

7 - Very fine day - Wind S.W. Went to Town, dined with Mr. Humphreys, Mr. Moore out in the evg. & staid all night.

8 - Fine cool day - Wind N.W. Went to Town & return'd to Dinner, Stewart commenc'd putting up Stone steps - Mrs. Bowly & Fanny call'd after Dinner & accompanied Mrs. T. to Mr. Peters & staid Tea, afterwards came & staid all Night at Clifton -
