15 - Fine day, Wind S. E -

Gatch's Land -

16 - Rain all forenoon & cloudy after,
Wind N. E. - Went to Town and
dined with Mr. S. Strett

17 - Rain & hazy all day - went to Town &
engaged at Court House trying Guize -
Dined with D. A. Smith in a hurry -
John Conrad taken very ill
