and afterwards with him to the Fort,
return'd to Dinner.

12 - Fine day, went to Town & dined at
S. Kerrets. - Mrs Wingman & Becky
Peters went to Town & return'd in the
evening with Anne Peters.

Mr. Peters call'd in the evening
13 - Fine day, went to Town & return'd to
Dinner, having a sore Throat.

14 - Being unwell, took Medicine & staid
at Home, Mrs Wingman & Becky Peters
went to Town, the former engag'd in
moving all her Furniture to Woodville.

Mr. Hare Poval & Rob. Patterson call'd
in the afternoon.

Showery all day, Wind N.E.
15 - Still Showery & cold Wind N.E.
Went to Town, dined with P. Wingman,
my Throat still sore.

Letty was married this evening to
Harry Williams.
