29th Clear fine day, intend setting off at 12 O'clock for Philad.^a in my Gig.

Sunday 6th June - Returned Home at One O'clock from Philad.^a I found all my Family well - Mr. Moore & Maria Peters dined with us.

Mary Bowly & Rebecca Wigram called, also in the ev. J. Wigram, Wm Bowly, S. Bennett, Augusta, Mary George, and Eliza Peters, the four last staid all night in consequence of a heavy Rain at sunset which lasted two Hours.

7th Very fine pleasant day, all our visitors went Home after breakfast.

Rode to Town & returned to Dinner. Fine day - went to Town, returned to Dinner - in the evening Mr. J. Smith & J. Patterson rode out, and partook of Strawberries & Cream.

Began mowing Clover in the new Orchard.
