afterwards walk'd with Mrs J. and
his sister Sally to Mr Peters, where
they drank Tea, he staid all Night

14 - Clear, cool day, went to Town
returned to Dinner, found Beckey,
Ann & Sally Peters, who with Mrs J.
Sally & Alex^r Stewart walk'd over
to Linley & returned to Tea

15 - Fine day, cloudy evening -
Went to Town returned to Dinner,
after which walk'd to Mr. Alex^r Browns
& spent an hour very pleasantly
