Bond to sell him Negro Sarah's
Freedom for two hundred dollars,
and at same time hired him
at \$10 $\frac{1}{2}$ month to work on the
Farm, but during Harvest he is

to have one Dollar $\frac{1}{2}$ day, and
so soon as he has earned or paid
\$200, Sal is to have her Freedom
in the mean time to live with
us as usual ~

Very fine day, went with all my hands
to Fortune, to thin the Woods, and cut
out all dead Trees &c, &c, ~

Dined at Home, & not in Town to day ~

December 1st A remarkable fine &
mild day, went to Town, returned
to dinner & afterwards to Fortune,
where my People are thinning the Woods.

2nd Very fine day but cool Wind N. W.
Went to Town, returned to Dinner &
afterwards rode to Furley & Fortune.

3rd Fine day but cool, went to
Town, returned to dinner, found Beeky
& Maria Peters, who staid all Night.

Clear evening Wind North ~
