11 - Clear & cold, hard Frost last night.  
Went to Town, dined at S. Steretts -

A meeting of the Horse Artillery  
at my Counting House to Elect their  
Officers, this evening -

Haul'd 9 Loads Ice to day, which  
fills the House, containing 5 1/2 Loads

Mr. Nicols call'd this evening -

Clear evening Wind North -
