14th Weather still cold, Wind S.E.

Went to Town, returned to Dinner

15th Rain all this day, Wind fresh, South,

Went to Town returned to Dinner, at
which had Mr. Nicols, expected Mr. Pringle
& S. Sterett but rain prevented them

16 - Very cold day - Wind N.W., having
cleared up last Night

Went to Town returned to Dinner,
preparing to Plant Thorn Hedges
