March 30 - Cloudy day with a few Showers
but more mild, Wind S. E. -

April 1st Very fine day - Wind N. W. -
Went to Town, rode by the Meadows, and
returned to Dinner -

Louisa Wigman died this morning at
4 O'clock, after six days illness -

2 - Beautiful day & very warm, Ther. 82
which is very unusual so early -

Went to Town, as also did Mrs. J. and
attended the Funeral of Louisa Wigman
at 10 O'clock, returned to Dinner -

4th Weather still cloudy Wind S. E. -

Paid Negro Joshua \$12 on acc. of Chesnut
Rails mauld at Fortune, who says he
kiss mauld 1963 - price 75 cents p. 100 -

Went to Town, returned to Dinner -
Commenced raining at 2 O'clock, and
continued all the evening with some
Thunder & Lightning -

5th Rained all last Night, cleared up
at 9 A. M. mild, Wind N. W. -

Went to Town returned to Dinner &
found W. Lux - R. Patterson, Amos &
& Cumberland Williams called in the ev. -
evening wind north -
