After dinner the following call'd,
staid Tea & Strawberries & Cream,
Mr. & Mrs Nicols, Col. Nicols, Mr. Holliday,
S. Herett, Augusta & Mary, Eliza Peters,
Geo. & James Brown -

We had pick'd out of the Garden
this day about 30 Quarts of Strawberries
and all our Friends had as many as
they could possibly eat, both at
Dinner & Tea -

6th Violent Thunder & heavy Rain last
Night, which continued nearly all day,
Wind N. E. - & so cold we have a Fire -
Went to Town, returned to Dinner -

Clear evening Wind North -
