Received two Pups from Mr Patterson of the Spanish Breed of Sheep Dogs -

6 - Fine Hot day - Ther. 80 - Wind S.W.

Staid at home to assist in getting up my Rye, haul'd 29 cart loads, made 3 Stacks & put a good deal in Barn Loft, did a great days work -

Mrs Stewart & Fanny Bowly came out to Dinner & afterwards to Teulay -

7 - Remarkably pleasant day Wind N.W. & Therm. only 70 -

Finished hauling up Rye, of which I have a large crop & in fine order -

Dined at home, & afterwards went to Town and exercised my Men at Artillery Drill in the Riding School, performed tolerably well -

Rebecca & Maria Peters dined at Clifton & staid all Night -

Had 10 Men mowing, making Hay & Stacking - beautiful evening
