& Mrs. & Fanny Bowly, afterwards Mrs. Hollins  
S. Hollins & Sally Stewart called & staid  
only a few minutes -

Mrs. Isaac McKim called in the morn.

3<sup>rd</sup> Hard Frost & clear morning -

Went to Town, & at 12 O'clock rode  
on Chinopin Hill to see a Man who was  
Sentenced by a Court Martial to be Shot,  
he was reprieved when on his knees  
expecting the fatal moment -

Dined with P. Wingman -

4<sup>th</sup> Sunday - Rainy morning, but cleared  
up at 10 O'clock with N. W. Wind -

Rode to Fairley & from thence to  
Col. So. Streets to Dinner -

5<sup>th</sup> Fine day, went to Town and  
returned to Dinner, sold 40 Hogs  
to Jacob Medinger -
