 27. Fine day - Wind N. W.
 Went to Town, returned to Dinner
 28. Pleasant clear day, went to Town
 dined with Mr. Konig
 29. Cloudy - Wind N. E. & cool
 Went to Town, cleared Ship Emily
 for Lisbon, dined nowhere
 30. Weather continues cloudy - N. E.
 Went to Town, the Emily sailed
 at half past nine O'clock for Lisbon,
 was out of the River at 1 O'clock
 dined with P. Wingman
