The following subjects are contained in the Report from Baltimore Quarterly Meeting, viz:

It is proposed to change a paragraph in our Book of Discipline, made in 1870, in relation to Men's and Women's Meetings, administering Discipline, and substitute the following: "That in the administration of Discipline, Men's and Women's Meetings may separately consider have the power of receiving, disowning and releasing members without specifying the cause of disownment, in all cases each Meeting giving the other information of their action, reserving the privilege in such cases as either may desire the assistance of the other."

"And for an additional paragraph to allow children that have but one parent a Member of Society, a Birthright Membership, to continue during their minority, if approved by both parents; after which allow them the choice of continuing in membership."

And when any of our Members absent themselves from our Meetings for a period of five years, without assigning a sufficient reason for such absence, Monthly Meetings may have the privilege of discontinuing them as Members.
