past year we have expended \$1965.⁵⁰ for educational purposes with
in the limits of our several Quarterly Meetings. Eleven Schools have
received aid, none of which were originally opened by the help of
this fund. Private individuals in a few cases have been assisted
in preparing themselves for teaching; in one case a part of the
money will be refunded. We believe that in this way much good
may result from the Fund. One individual who is now successful
by teaching, has refunded \$75.⁰⁰ since our last report.
