The Committee on Education made the following report, viz:

To Baltimore Yearly Meeting:-

The Committee on Education, during last year, have held several conferences to consider subjects touching the educational interests of society.

During the Yearly Meeting week of 1876, they met, organized, and received from the Clerk of the Yearly Meeting the minute instructing them to take action in the matter of establishing "within our borders a school in which children of both sexes may receive a plain, practical education combining the use of muscle with a development of mind, at an expense that could be borne by a large majority of our members."

This subject was referred to a committee, who were requested to give it due consideration, and report.
