the limits of our several Quarterly meetings the sum of \$1,054.38. Eight schools have been aided, five of which were under the care of Monthly or Preparative Meetings.

The aggregate number of Friend's Children in these schools was One hundred and thirty nine. Six individuals

who attended other schools were also aided, and one at Swarthmore College who went to prepare himself for teaching.

Fifty dollars have been refunded since our last report by one who was aided by the Fund and is now teaching.

We recommend that Ann R. Branson of Kaseville be appointed on this Committee in place of Martha Sidwell who has removed to reside within the limits of another meeting, and Anne Walton of Woodlawn in place of Sarah E. Wright, deceased.

The Committee desires it to be understood that all applications for money by the members of any Monthly meeting should come to the Executive Committee through the member of this committee belonging to that meeting.
