It was directed to be signed by the clerk, and returned to the Representative Committee to be recorded.

9 Edward Stabler Sr., Edwin Blackburn and Eli M. Lamb, were appointed to assist the clerks in revising and preparing the Extracts of our minutes for publication, together with such selections from the minutes of the Representative Committee as may be deemed advisable.

10 To examine and settle the Treasurer's accounts; propose the name of a suitable Friend for Treasurer, and the amount necessary to be raised to defray the expenses of the Meeting the ensuing year, the following committee was appointed:
