

1884. They found great earnestness there and all our members concerned to have a Friends school in the broadest sense of that term. A teacher has been engaged and the prospect is, that the school will be opened by the middle of next month.

This is the only new school of which we have to report, but we can say that none of our older ones have retrograded. Our Washington School is conspicuously in advance of the position at this time last year. Nearly twice as many names are enrolled as there were at that time and the grade of the School has been very much raised. As first Assistant therein, is engaged a young Friend who was fitted as teacher entirely in one of our own Schools.

At Sandy Spring our new School is in a very flourishing and satisfactory condition. The schools at Gumpowder, Little Falls, Pipe Creek, and the three in Nottingham Quarter, all present encouraging reports and show an earnest and increasing zeal to have educational facilities of a high order, and just such as Friends desire, within reach of all our children.

The following table will give what we have received from our constituent branches in the line of statistics. By which we find 686 pupils under care of Friends in our own Schools. To this number must be added 54 who were reported verbally from schools from schools under care of Friends, but not under care of any Meeting, which raises the total to 740.
