Herewith we present a statistical report, which will show the present condition of our charge. We show the schools, their Superintendents with their addresses, and the number of children attending them.

Nine schools met before and sixteen after Meetings. All schools except one met every Firstday during their terms. Some vacate in Summer time, others in Winter.

In addition to Lesson Leaves, the Discipline and the Bible are books usually taught, though many are the books of reference used by our teachers.

In our work we have expended one hundred and fifty (\$150) dollars for Lesson Leaves, \$10.47 for stationery and postage, and \$24.30 in payment of travelling expenses of a representative to the General Conference held in Eighth month last, and we owe \$5.75 for programmes for the Youth's

Firstday Meeting of last Firstday, making in all \$190.52.

Should the Yearly Meeting approve of continuing the work and appoint another Committee, we respectfully ask that the sum of two hundred dollars be set aside for their use during the coming year.
