Eighth Query. Do Friends bear a testimony against oaths, military services, clandestine trade, prize goods, and lotteries; and also against all forms of oppression?

Eighth Answer. Our testimony is borne against oaths, military services, clandestine trade, prize goods, and lotteries, also against most forms of oppression.

Ninth Query. Is care taken to deal with offenders seasonably and impartially, and to win to those who will not be reclaimed, the spirit of meekness and love before they are disowned?
