The Youth's Meeting held on Firstday afternoon was an unusually impressive one, showing the excellent work that is being done in some of our Firstday Schools.

After the regular exercises from the several schools, we were favored with an address by Joseph St. Bogardus, which was replete with food for thought.

During the year we have received from Elisha H. Walker, Treasurer, one hundred and eighty dollars (\$180), which, with the balance on hand from the former appropriation, thirty-seven dollars and two cents (\$37.02), makes a total of two hundred and seventeen dollars and two cents (\$217.02), and have expended one hundred and eighty dollars (\$180) for Lesson Leaves, ten dollars and seventy-five cents (\$10.75) for postals and printing, and two dollars and thirty-one cents (\$2.31), for stationery and postage, total one hundred and ninety-three dollars and six cents (\$193.06), leaving a balance on hand of twenty-three dollars and ninety-six cents (\$23.96).

Should the Yearly Meeting approve the labors of the Committee during the past year and desire a continuance of the same, we respectfully ask that the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200), be appropriated for their use during the ensuing year.
