

According to the conclusion of Baltimore Quarterly Meeting of Friends held the 14th of the 5th Month 1807. a division of Baltimore Monthly Meeting was approved as follows

That Meeting in future to be called the Monthly Meeting of Baltimore for the Eastern District, and the Meeting proposed to be established to be distinguished by the name the Monthly Meeting of Baltimore for the Western District, and held in the Meeting house on Lombard Street. The two Meetings to be divided by the following line:— The Friends residing west of the line of Calvert Street until it intersects Jones' Falls, and with said Falls, to the road called "the Falls Turnpike," and with that road, to be considered the line of division. To this Monthly Meeting the Friends of Elbridge Pearsall Meeting were by their request added.

The following is a list of Friends composing the Monthly Meeting of Baltimore for the Western District at the time of its establishment. To which are added such names as have from time to time been acknowledged by that Meeting together with such notes of Births, Deaths, Removals, &c. proper to be entered upon record.
