Fourth Query

Friends are clear of giving aid in the manufacture, sale and use of intoxicating liquors. They avoid places where liquors are sold, and places of demoralizing tendencies. They discourage the cultivation and use of Tobacco and other narcotics.

Fifth Query

None of our members appear to require aid at this time.

Sixth Query

Our Friends are careful to a faithful testimony in favor of a free Gospel Ministry resting upon Divine qualification.

Seventh Query

Our Friends are careful to live within their income, and to avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage. are just in their dealing, punctual in complying with their engagements and prompt in fulfilling their obligations.

Eighth Query

Friends maintain a faithful testimony against war and the preparations for war. They discourage cards, billiards, and gambling, and must friends of oppression.

Ninth Query

We have a First-day School under the care of our meeting. No Young Men's Association, nor organized philanthropic work.

Tenth Query

Care is taken to keep a record of births, deaths and membership.
