4 Month 12. 1843 - Ingram & Peacock, agree with the Committee having charge of the Meeting House & Premises, Lombard Street - to give his services as hitherto, for the compensation of ten dollars a month for the year round - and to make no extra charge for clearing off snow nor for cutting and removing grass
