In the year 1808, she joined in marriage with our friend Jeremiah Brown, and came to reside among us,

an approved minister, from upper Springfield Monthly Meeting aforesaid, and laboured faithfully in the cause of truth and righteousness, not only amongst us, but also in visiting distant meetings in various parts; the last weighty service of this kind in which she was engaged, was a religious visit in the summer of 1819, to the families of friends within the compass of Baltimore Monthly Meeting for the western district, which she performed to the comfort and satisfaction of friends generally.

She was endowed with a clear and comprehensive mind, and by submitting to the direction of her Divine Master, was made useful
