But as this Meeting has adopted measures in relation to those meetings in the operation, it was believed that way would shortly open for such to obtain certificates of removal in the usual manner. The Clerk was directed to forward a copy of this Minute with the Epistle to Ohio Yearly Meeting.

The committee appointed to have reprinted our Tracts and copies of the General Epistle and minute issued by the yearly Meeting of Friends in London, reported that the service had been attended to. The Representatives were directed to take charge of their Distribution.

Copy of Epistles to the Yearly Meetings of Friends in London, and to those on this continent were now produced by the Committee, which were read, corrected and approved, and the Clerk was directed to transcribe, sign and forward them.

Having been favoured to bring to a close in great Harmony and unity, the many weighty and important concerns which have come before us at this time, with hearts sincerely thankful for the many mercies and favours which we have experienced, the meeting concluded. To meet if so permitted next year on 2d day the 18th of the 10th Month and the Meeting for Ministers and Elders the 7th day preceding at the usual hour.

Our Friends Jonathan Backhouse & Hannah Chapman Backhouse from Great Britain attended this meeting & produced a Certificate from Darlington Monthly Meeting of Friends held at Darlington 16th of 3rd Month 1830 endorsed by the Quarterly Meeting of December the 6th of the 4th Month 1830 & also a Certificate from the Yearly Meeting of Ministers held in London on the 17th 18th 19th & 29th of the 5th Mo 1830 all expressing of near unity & sympathy with them in their project of making a Religious Visit to Friends on this Continent.
