Believing the counsel, admonition & encouragement contained therein might be usefully diffused among our members the meeting concluded to have 500 copies thereof reprinted for distribution and George Williamson and Joseph Towns are appointed to agree with the printer inspect the proofs & call on the Treasurer for the expense incurred.
