We the Committee appointed to examine & adjust the Treasurer's account, Report: that we have attended to our appointment. We have examined his account & vouchers & find them correct and a balance remaining in his hands of one hundred and ninety one Dollars 66 Cents the quotas being all paid in. and we recommend that one hundred & fifty Dollars be raised the ensuing year Baltimore Quarter to raise two thirds of said sum & Nottingham one third which we submit to the meeting. The Committee appointed at a former sitting produced as directed Epistles of Correspondence to the Yearly Meetings of Friends held in London & Dublin & to them on this continent which were read & with some corrections approved & directed to be transcribed & signed & forwarded.

Through the continued mercy & loving kindness of the Blessed Head of the Church we have been enabled to transact the many weighty & important concerns which have come before us at this time in unity & harmony. Under feelings

of thankfulness for the favor the meeting concludes: - to meet at the usual time next year if the Lord permit.

At a Yearly meeting of Friends held in Baltimore for the Western Shore of Maryland and the adjacent parts of Pennsylvania & Virginia by adjournment from the 28th of the 10th month to the 29th of the same inclusive 1835.

By Reports received from the quarterly meetings it appears that the following named friends are representatives viz from Baltimore Isaac Brooks, Nicholas Popplein, Samuel Cary, Thomas Scott, Jonah Jones, William Procter, John Cook and John P. Balderston. From Nottingham David Ericson, Joseph T. Balance, Elisha Cook and Samuel Worthington who were present except one for whom a letter was received as reviewed.

Epistles of Correspondence from the Yearly Meetings of friends held in London & Dublin and one from each of those on this continent were received & read. These testimonies of brotherly love & Christian fellowship were truly acceptable & satisfactory, and the following names of friends were appointed to prepare & produce to a future sitting essays of Epistles in reply to them viz Samuel Cary, Joseph Townsend, David Ericson, Joseph & Mary, John P. Balderston, George Wilson, Isaac Brooks, Thomas Worthington, John Dakehart, Thomas Waring, Isaac & Anne, Daniel Cobb, Joseph T. Balance, Thomas Cook, William Waring, John Dakehart, Anomus Holgate and Anne Newlin.

Several minutes and one certificate were presented to the meeting by brethren & sisters now attending with us from within the limits of Neighboring Yearly Meetings which were read & were acceptable. Nicholas Popplein & Joseph Cook were appointed to unite with a similar Committee of former Friends in preparing a suitable encouragement to be placed on them & produce it to a future sitting. The Representatives are desired to confer together at the close of this sitting & agree on two friends to serve the Meeting as Clerk & Assistant Clerk this year to be proposed at the opening of next sitting.
