Baltimore Yearly Meeting. 1864

At a Yearly Meeting of Friends, held in Baltimore, for the Western Shore of Maryland, Virginia, and the adjacent parts of Pennsylvania, by adjournments from the 24th of the 10th month, to the 27th of the same, inclusive. 1864

By Reports received from the Quarterly Meetings it appears that the following Friends have been appointed Representatives to the Yearly Meeting, viz:

From Baltimore. - John Scott, Richard Mc Lannan, Thomas R. McCallister, Abel S. Hopkins, Jesse Tyson, George P. Cook, George Mason and James C. Thomas.

From Dummings Creek. - William A. Thomas, William McNaught, Thomas McCoy, Samuel Way, Jr. and Zachariah McNaught - who were present except one, for whose absence a reason was given.

Intercourse with our Meetings in Virginia being still prevented by the war, no Report has been received from the Half Year's Meeting of Virginia, and the one from Baltimore Quarterly Meeting, does not embrace two meetings in Virginia, within its limits.

Our beloved friend, Joseph James Neave, a minister, attended this meeting and produced a Certificate from Woodbridge Monthly Meeting, held at Woodbridge, Suffolk County, England, dated the 7th and 14th of 9th month 1864, endorsed by Suffolk Quarterly Meeting, held 9th Mo. 16th 1864, and by the Meeting of Ministers and Elders, held in London, 9th Mo. 26th. 1864; all expressive of unity and sympathy with him in his prospect of religious service within the limits of Baltimore and North Carolina Yearly Meetings, which were acceptably read in this Meeting.

Our beloved friend, William Norton, an elder, attended this Meeting and produced a Certificate from Woodbridge Monthly Meeting, held at Ipswich, in the County of Suffolk, England, dated 10th Mo. 15th 1864, liberating him to accompany our dear friend Jos J Neave, in his attendance at our Yearly Meeting and other religious service in this land, which was acceptably read in this Meeting.
