Baltimore Yearly Meeting 1865.

At a Yearly Meeting of Friends, held in Baltimore, for the Western Shore of Maryland, Virginia, and the adjacent parts of Pennsylvania, by adjournment from the 23^d of the 10th month, to the 27th of the same, inclusive, 1865.
