We earnestly commend this worthy Institution to the liberality of our members, and to all other friends of the colored Orphans.

In bringing the business of the Meeting to a close, we record with reverent gratitude the unity and love which have prevailed from sitting to sitting, and the precious seasons of spiritual refreshment with which our Holy Head has been pleased to bless us. Under unhumbling sense of their mercies, which have been new every morning, the Meeting concluded to meet again next year, at the stated time, if the Lord permit.
