4 The Representatives were directed to confer together, and propose to our next sitting two Friends to serve this Meeting as Clerk, and Assistant Clerk, for the ensuing year. Then adjourned to second day morning at 10 o'clock.

The Meeting convened according to adjournment.

5 Jos. Scott, on behalf of the Representatives, reported they had conferred together, and were united in proposing Francis T. King for Clerk, and Jos. Carey for Assistant Clerk, which was united with by the Meeting, and they were appointed to the representative stations.

6 Thos. White, Jeph Tyson, Zachariah Mc. Haul, Richd. W. Rip, David White, and Thos. R. Hackett, were appointed to examine, and settle the Treasurer's account, report the state of the stock, and estimate the amount required for the ensuing year, and report to a future sitting.

7 The Meeting being informed that a vacancy has occurred in this Meeting's representation in the Meeting for Sufferings occasioned by the death of our late friend Daniel P. Haviland, we appoint Aaron H. Griffith, Richd. W. Jannet, Jos. C. Thomas, Thos. Mc. Coy and Jos. Prithow, to name to our next Meeting, a suitable Friend to fill that vacancy.

8 A minute from Western Yearly Meeting, was read in reference to the proposed Conference in 1821 and seriously considered, and it is the judgment of this and Western's

Meetings, that way does not open at this time to unite in the union, and our Clerks were directed to furnish Western Yearly Meeting, with a copy of this minute.

9 The following minute was received from Indiana Yearly Meeting, and we approve of the application of the funds therein referred to:

Our Committee to close up the affairs connected with the Shawnee Mission, inform us, that there has been received something more than \$7.00, which has been invested by our Treasurer in United States Bonds - the interest to be paid to the Associated Executive Committee of Indian affairs, to be used for Indian civilization."

10 The prospect of establishing a Yearly Meeting in Kansas, within the present limits of Indiana Yearly Meeting, in the 10th month, has warmed our hearts, with warm interest and feeling, to our distant brethren who are about assuming the responsibilities and privileges of a Yearly Meeting, and desiring to welcome them into the Brotherhood of Yearly Meetings, we direct our Committee upon Epistles to prepare an Epistle, to be read at the opening of that Meeting, and we appoint Francis T. King, Thos. Mc. Coy, and Jos. Prithow, to present to a future sitting, the names of suitable Friends, to attend the opening of said Yearly Meeting on our behalf.

11 The minutes of last year were read. The Committee to record them reported that the service had been attended to, they were continued to record those of the present year, and report to next Yearly Meeting.

Then adjourned to 10 o'clock 2d day, 10th Mo. 26th day.
