

Minutes of Baltimore Yearly Meeting 1879.

- 1 At a Yearly Meeting of Friends held in Baltimore for the Western Part of Maryland, Virginia and the adjacent parts of Pennsylvania, by adjournments from the 18th to the 23^d of the 10th month, inclusive, 1879.
- 2 By Reports from Quarterly Meetings & the Half Yearly Meetings of Virginia, the following friends were appointed Representatives of this Meeting, viz.

- 3 Minutes were read for the following brethren and sisters in attendance from other Yearly Meetings, and James Carey, Thos. McCoy & Jno. Pettlow were appointed to unite with a committee of women Friends to prepare Indorsements to be placed in the minutes, & produce them to a future sitting viz.

- 4 The minutes of last year were read & the Committee to record them reported that the service had been attended to. They were continued to read those of this year and report next year.
- 5 Jesse Tyson, by Griffith, Zachariah McNaul, Richard A. Ricks and Isaac H. Thompson were appointed to examine and settle the Treasurer's account, report the state of treasury, & the sum required for the ensuing year.
- 6 The following proposition for change in the time of holding Duncunings Creek Quarterly Meeting was considered & approved & the change will take effect from this time, viz.
 A proposition has been indorsed by this Meeting to change the holding of our quarterly meeting into that of a four months meeting, in the following order, viz. To be held on last second day of the first month, at Burrowsville, in Clearfield County, Pennsylvania; on the last second day in fifth month, at Bellefonte Centre County, Penna; and on the last second day of the ninth month at Duncunings Creek, Adams Co. Penna. The Meeting on Ministry and Oversight to be held at half past nine o'clock on the same day (it being Friday evening) which is submitted to the Yearly Meeting.
