In all parts of our Yearly Meeting, in view of the need there is for this time have agreed to request the Yearly Meeting to provide a fund to defray the traveling expenses of the Committee, in attending the General Meetings that may be appointed during the year coming. They also ask that the Committee may be re-appointed this year.
