Foreign Mission Report.

The Committee on Foreign Missions report that six meetings of the Friends' Foreign Mission Association of Baltimore have been held. An appeal to our members has been prepared and inserted in the Friends' Review, 250 copies of it have been printed separately, and are now ready for distribution. A Foreign Mission Band has been formed of Friends' children, which has already sent \$6.00 to Brumana and \$6.00 to Beelgania. A public meeting on Foreign Missions has been held at Federal Hill, and also one at Patuxent. Great interest was awakened in both places, resulting in much larger contributions in proportion to their ability than from almost any other quarter. The Committee hope that there will be more general interest in the cause the coming year throughout the Yearly Meeting, and would especially commend Friend's Mexican Mission to the liberality of our members.
