

Incorporation, the Trustees of the Miles White Beneficial Society present the following report of their transactions for the past year.

Since the last Annual Report, there have been no changes made in the Investments of the Funds, which are at present in the same securities as then reported, from which interest to the amount of \$5.498 has been received.

Of this amount, \$4.080 has been distributed as follows: \$2.775 for Charitable Objects, \$1.386 for Educational Purposes, and \$229 for the Dissemination of Books and Tracts.
