Report of the Pastoral Committee

The members of the Executive Committee living in Baltimore,
 and the co-operating Committee appointed by the
 Monthly Meeting have as usual held regular Monthly
 Meetings, except during the Seventh, Eighth, and
 Ninth months. They have prayerfully considered the
 needs of the different Meetings, and have kept in
 communication with them, and have encouraged the
 workers in the various places by their sympathy and
 advice. The travelling expenses of those who felt
 drawn to go and labor in our Meetings have
 been defrayed by the fund appropriated by the Yearly
 Meeting, and Ministers of the Gospel from other
 Yearly Meetings have also been cared for in the same
 way from time to time. We would acknowledge the
 answer to our prayer that more laborers might be
 sent into our harvest-fields, for there has been an
 unusual number of ministers visiting parts of our
 Yearly Meeting for a longer or shorter time during
 the year.

The Meeting in Baltimore has been much blessed
 this year; there is a marked growth in the spiritual
 life and earnestness of our members and attenders.
 The after meetings held at the conclusion of our
 regular First day morning meetings have been well
 attended, and have been helpful and stimulating. They
 were discontinued during the summer months, but
 have now been resumed. A Children's meeting was held
 once a month for seven months, and has been begun
 again this fall. A number of visits to families have
 been paid by members of the Pastoral Committee during
 the year. A series of meeting for united prayer for a
 blessing on our Meeting was held for one week in first
 month last. Also a series of meetings in the second
 month, lasting for ten days at which time Caroline
 C. Talbot was acceptably with us.
