and an answer was appointed to be writt to London
brought to y^e next yearly meeting at West River and
to that of Burlington against 7th mo
a paper was read in this meeting that inagon & way
disown that disorderly spirit & if y^e want of love
given way to it, in antedating y^e privileges of
the Marriage Bed wherby they have had
before y^e accomplishment of y^e due time after
marriage which was sign for y^e clearing of
Innocent Truth of y^e scandal wherby brought upon
