 Eastern shore Meeting none appears to give account —

 y. 18th of y. 7 mo. 1745 was read at this Meeting, and to
 the Satisfaction of friends, and Likewise a few Lines
 drawn in answer, which was well approved of. Signed
 and Delivered to Michael Lightfoot —
 This Meeting adjourns till y. next yearly Meeting held
 at this Place —

At our yearly Meeting of women friends held at Westmore
 y. 6th of y. 4 mo. 1747 — After settling together to wait
 upon y. Lord, this Meeting Proceeds to inspect into the
 Meetings thereunto belonging —

by accounts brought in from our several quarterly Meetings
 it appears, that Meetings for y. most part are kept up
 except one quarterly Meeting, which was occasioned by
 extremity of weather, Love and Unity Subjects amongst
 friends, on whose minds remains a care for y. Discipline
 to revive, a Delention therein appearing —

The Epistle from y. Women friends in Burlington was read
 in this Meeting to y. Satisfaction of friends and answered
 as usual —

 Next yearly Meeting to be held at this Place —
